Garden of Mercy Specific Disclosures

- As of Jan 1, 2021 a monument sign will be erected by City of Coppell to identify Garden of Mercy.
- All plots will be facing direction of Mecca as per agreement with Coppell City Council. This direction has been confirmed independently by our Imam.
- Only one grave memorial/marker is permitted per plot in order to maintain the uniformity of the cemetery. The purchase price includes a standardized 24x12x4 Flat Gray Granite Memorial monument, taxes, storage and itching. The memorial is restricted to only capture name of deceased, date of birth and date of death.
- Additionally an option to pre-purchase Concrete Vault at a flat discounted rate of \$600 per each plot is available during the pre-sell period. Vaults will be stored free of charge by cemetery until usage time. This will lock the price for this item and is to be paid in full to Rodriguez Graveside Services at the time of signing the contract. This price is current and will vary in the future.
- Opening and closing for burials are to be scheduled Monday through Saturday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at \$1200 for each occurrence. Sunday burials are available only at 3 p.m. at \$1500 for each occurrence. Cutoff for same day burial notification is 12:00 noon. These prices are current and will vary in the future.
- Should you desire to sell your plots in the future, such transaction must be facilitated by the Coppell Islamic Cemetery Committee led by Mohamed Elmougy (Tel. 214-562-8190) to insure adherence to Garden of Mercy policies. Rolling oaks Cemetery management will insure adherence to this clause.
- A \$500 transfer fee per plot will be charged by city for ownership change after purchase.
- Following the funeral or burial, burning incense or candles is strictly forbidden as are placing pictures/statues of any kind.
- No change of grading, moving soil or edging/ditch is permitted.
- Construction of any kind or shape, not limited to canopy, bricks, concrete, metal hedge, fence (wood metal) is not permitted.
- Any type of boxes, toys, glass vase etc. cannot be kept at the grave site. Planting trees, flowers, shrubs are not permitted.
- Coppell Islamic Cemetery Committee will facilitate selling and burial process at Garden of Mercy according to Islamic traditions.
- If any of the above rules are not followed, Cemetery will take appropriate corrective actions and charge back the undersigned purchaser/co-purchaser for costs associated with such action.
